

Instructions

1. Print this file using Xerox Colour Xpressions 24lb paper. Colour Xpressions will produce high quality consistent results on colour copiers and digital presses. Other non-digital papers may not produce consistent results.
2. Compare each page for defects. If there are defects in one colour replace the drum. On some machines you can clean the corotrons or ROS window. Clean the required maintenance actions and run the test file again.
3. If there are defects in all colours place a service call.
4. If test results are satisfactory on Xerox Colour Xpressions, run the test on the paper you are using and compare the results. If the results on the other paper are not optimum, review the Materials Usage Guide and Recommended Materials List for your machine to determine how to get better results. If it is the paper, ask your paper supplier for a digital paper that is optimized for colour copiers and digital presses.
